If you are requesting funding, please be sure to give particular justification information about how the Delaware INBRE funds will be used for the activity/event. A follow up report will be required to report on evaluation metrics within 6 – 12 months.
- Budget.** For funds requested, a budget specifically noting what amounts will be spent on person(s) supported, supplies required, travel if necessary or any/all other items to specifically be covered by Delaware INBRE funds should be itemized and identified. Please indicate any and all results from previous year's activity/events if applicable to justify budget requirements. These budget items will support not only our records, but also the state and NIH records should any questions arise.
- Payment.** As the university employs various methods of payment and/or reimbursement, in order for your request to be processed, original invoices must be submitted to the Delaware INBRE office.

Review. Once the proposal (and budget if requested) have been completed and submitted, the package will be forwarded to the appropriate reviewers for the approval process. If any questions should arise, these will be relayed to you for clarity. A final decision based on the review as to whether Delaware INBRE will proceed with the request will then be made once the approval process is complete. If funds are approved, please allow 45 days minimum for funds to be forwarded to you or your institution.
